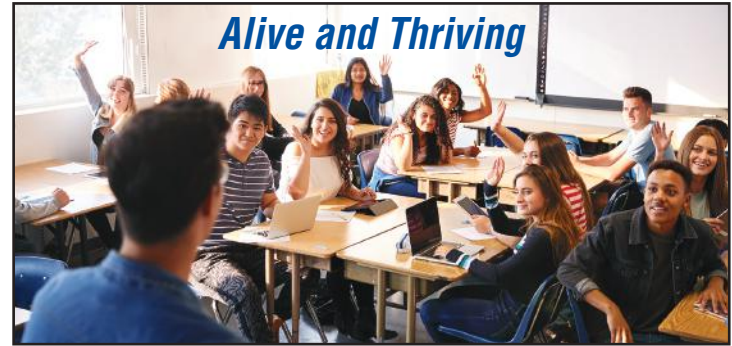


Schools must provide “Enriching Classroom Experiences”.
