## Schools must provide "Enriching Classroom Experiences".

Education should promote <u>individualism and self-reliance</u>, not "group think" and dependency. The "**Collective Experience**" of public school education

developing <u>social skills in children is a **myth**</u>. Socialization development must be more <u>vertical</u> than horizontal. When we collectively educate, and socially cultivate, we get the "<u>mainstream culture</u>" that is base and lacking the values that parents want for their children.



Classrooms must be <u>alive and thriving learning environments</u> that encourage: civil discourse and debate; problem-solving; making good decisions; being focused; truth and reason; self-regulation; and, student achievement.

Teachers will be trained in <u>best practices</u> for classroom learning that incorporates **Socialization Skills Development** that **positively affect** the success of the student in school. Classroom enrichment will be evaluated. "We don't want to socialize our kids out of a good education."
