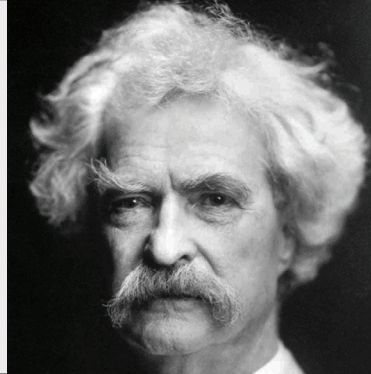


Final Thoughts
